STAINED GLASS CHECKLIST

Every stained glass window possesses unique characteristics that necessitate an individualized approach to conservation, restoration or maintenance. Fortunately, there are a number of general guidelines that can assist in determining the need for a professional inspection of your windows.

GLASS BREAKAGE			
Breakage may be caused by a number factors, including impact to the glass, structural stresses brought about by improper or inadequate reinforcement, or weakness inherent in the glass itself. Glass breakage can best be detected in transmitted light - light coming through the window from the sun or another source.

SAGGING OR BOWING C	GLASS PANELS		
Sagging and bowing is most often the result of structural inadequacies and can be compounded by expansion and contraction due to temperature changes and structural shifting. Once stained glass has deviated from its original plane, corrective action is usually required. Sagging or bowing is most easily viewed in reflected light, which is present in a lighted interior at night.

DETERIORATED LEAD			
Lead deteriorates for many reasons, including inappropriate original ingredients, exposure to chemicals and pollutants, stress on the panel, and improper repairs or poorly excuted restoration attempts. Look for cracking and oxidation of the lead in reflected light.

FADED OR PEELING PAIN	IT		
Paint usually deteriorates because it was not fired at a temperature high enough to ensure proper adhesion to the glass. It can also deteriorate due to an improper paint mixture.

Stained glass usually deteriorates slowly at first, but damage can rapidly accelerate as vital components begin to break down. It is essential to take a pro-active approach to conservation, restoration and maintenance in order to prevent further damage to the stained glass panels.
